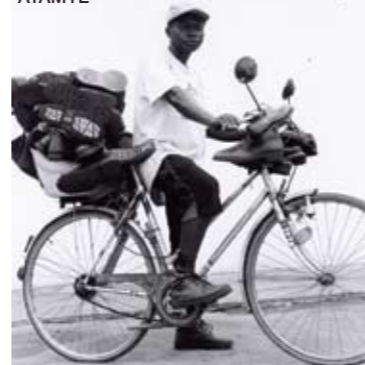

These two individuals are very different from each other, the common thread being the need for transportation and the wish for positive development in their community. "Ayamyé" is a moving, life-affirming film that proves sustainable solutions to crisis are not always complex.

This film features the characters of that day such as Gary Fisher, Joe Breeze, Charlie Kelly and Alan Bonds. The races began among friends getting stoned, partying and flying down the mountain on their pre-'40s bikes with fat tires: "Klunkerz."

Those fun escapades turned into a sport that changed - and maybe even saved - the bike industry. Now, all over the world, you see people riding mountain bikes.

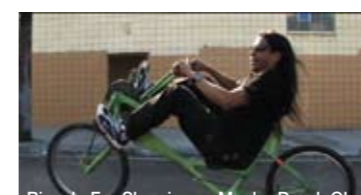
